

HOW TO GET TO KAUNAS?

The city of Kaunas is located in the centre of Lithuania, 100 km north-west of Vilnius. The city can easily be reached by plane, train or coach.



BY PLANE

Kaunas international airport (KUN) is a small, modern airport situated in Karmélava (about 14 km northeast of the Kaunas city centre). Low fare airlines Ryanair and Wizz Air operate between Kaunas and 17 different European cities. City bus No 29G connects Kaunas airport and Kaunas city centre for the most affordable price 1 €.

Vilnius Airport (VNO) is the main international airport in Lithuania situated 5km from the centre of Vilnius (and 100 km from Kaunas) where central train and bus stations are located. Thus, you will have to take a train, a City bus No 1 or a taxi to reach Vilnius Train or Bus Stations (stations are located in a walking distance from each other) where you will have to take a train or coach to Kaunas. 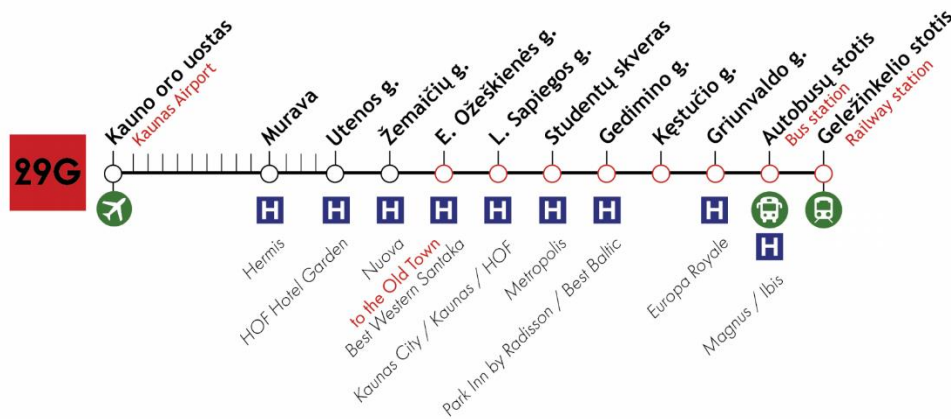
BY BUS NO. 29G FROM KAUNAS AIRPORT TO CITY CENTRE

Kaunas city busses are red (route numbers 00 to 68), while trolleybuses are bright green color (route numbers 1 to 16). There is a **direct bus route 29G** that goes from Kaunas Airport to the city center, bus and railway stations (and back).

BY TAXI FROM KAUNAS AIRPORT TO CITY CENTRE

Kaunas Airport approved taxi rank can be found just in front of the arrivals terminal. All taxi cabs accept cash and credit cards. Most popular routes and their rates:

Kaunas Airport – Old Town (Town Hall Square) – ca. 20 EUR*

Kaunas Airport – Bus station – ca. 19 EUR*

Kaunas Airport – Freedom avenue – ca. 18 EUR*

* Taxi carriers carrying passengers from Kaunas Airport taxi rank must apply not higher rates than the following:

1 km daytime trip, from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. - 1.00 EUR

1 km nighttime trip, from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. - 1.20 EUR

1 km at weekends and on public holidays - 1.20 EUR

1 km outside the city - 1.30 EUR

Initial fare - 1.10 EUR



TRANSFER FROM VILNIUS AIRPORT TO KAUNAS CITY

There is a direct bus connection from Vilnius to Kaunas. The journey takes 1.5-2 hours. For the coach timetables please visit the website: www.autobusubilietai.lt

Kaunas Bus Station (Kauno autobusų stotis) is located on Vytauto pr. 24.

The distance between Vilnius International Airport (VNO) and Kaunas is 92 km. The road distance is 100.7 km. There are three ways to get from Vilnius Airport (VNO) to Kaunas – by bus, train, or car. The best way to get from Vilnius International Airport (VNO) to Kaunas [is by bus](#). The bus ride takes 1 hour 34 minutes, and the ticket costs about 7.50 – 9€ (from Vilnius bus station to Kaunas bus station). Alternatively, it is possible to [take the train](#). The train journey takes from 1 hour 16 minutes to 1 hour 41 minutes and the ticket costs 6.40 – 9€ (from Vilnius train station to Kaunas train station).

BY ROAD TO KAUNAS

Being the major city closest to the center of Lithuania, Kaunas is easily accessible by car and bus. Major four-lane highways directly connect it to Vilnius and Klaipėda. Via Baltica road (mostly two-lane) go southwards to Poland and northwards to Latvia via Panevėžys. Travelling to Kaunas by car is hassle-free from Riga, Warsaw, Vilnius, Klaipėda and pretty much the rest of the cities in the surrounding region.

You have to pay for parking in the central part of Kaunas 8 am-6 pm from Monday to Friday (no charge on weekends – except the Town Hall Square, where the hours are 8 am - midnight), except public holidays. To pay for parking, you can use the Unipark and m.Parking apps, your contactless bank card or Euro coins.



BY TRAIN

If you choose to travel by train, there is a direct connection from Vilnius to Kaunas. Train tickets can be purchased at the station or in train. The journey takes approx. 1.5 hours.

Kaunas Railway Station (geležinkelio stotis) is located right in the city centre. For routes and timetable of trains please visit the website: www.traukiniobilietas.lt

How to get to the Santaka Valley

From the city centre and old town to Santaka Valley run trolleybuses no. 5, 7, 13, 16 and buses no. 39, 45, 54 and 57G. Trip duration is about 20-25 minutes and about 7 – 10 stops. A single-use ticket price is 1 Eur.
